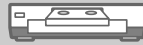

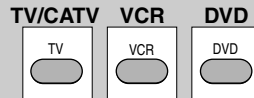

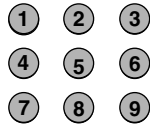
Actual operations depend on your equipment and software. Be sure to read the instructions for the receiver and your other components.

## You may need to enter a code to operate some equipment.

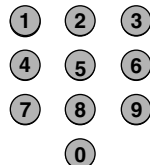
### Changing the codes



Press and hold the button corresponding to the equipment



Enter the first digit



Enter the second digit

The remote control outputs the on/off signal. If the code is correct, the equipment turns on or off. If it doesn't, try entering another code.

This remote control can operate Panasonic and Technics audiovisual equipment that have remote control sensors. You may need to change the remote control code.

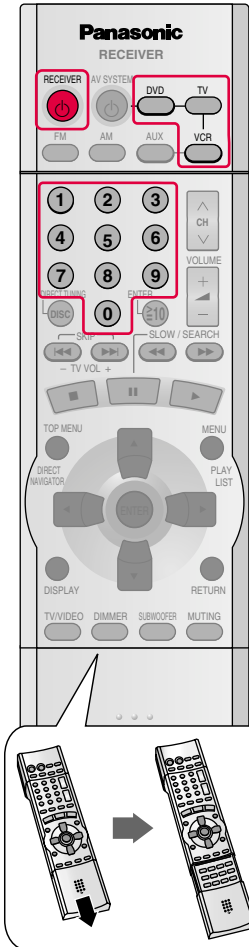
It can also operate some other brands of televisions, video cassette players, and DVD players. Check the table for the brand and enter the code as follows.

- Note that this remote control cannot operate some equipment and that it may not be able to perform some operations.
- Reenter the codes after you change the batteries.
